Biennial Arborist Review	Trees reviewed by arborist to ensure proper pruning for health and safety, diagnose diseases and encourage longevity
Biennial Health Check	Low maintance; recommend cyclical or frequent inspections to ensure no rot/grubs/ infection are afflicting these high priority plants.
Biennial Regenerative Prune	Cyclical pruning may improve overall aesthetic + promote lush, dense growth
Blank	Respond appropriately to plant behavior; generally requires little maintainence
Integrated Pest Management	Follow recommended approach to common problems; avoid in-organic/chemical solutions. Integrated Pest Management utilizes methods with lowest negative ecological impact + is often organic. Reference BPMs or Pima SmartScapes for further recommendations
Little to None	Emphasis on low-maintainence of species; respond appropriately to plant health utilizing BPMs
Seasonal Fertilization	Requires fertilization for optimal performance
Seasonal Pruning	Seasonal pruning may improve overall aesthetic
